NAD welcomes new Excos



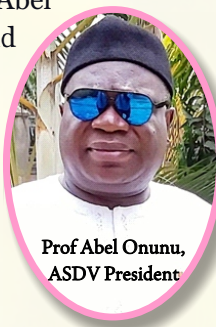
The esteemed outgoing EXCO of the NAD, led by Dr Grace C Okudo, completed two tenures as the executive


